CIDI 3.0 Training

The University of Michigan CIDI Training and Reference Center provides training on the World Health Organization CIDI Version 3.0, which is an expanded and updated version of CIDI 2.1. Our next training session is scheduled for September 14-16, 2009 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. We usually hold 1-2 training sessions per year, or more often if we have enough demand.

The cost for training is \$2,500 per participant (\$1,500 for students and trainees, when accompanied by a letter from their academic advisor confirming that the individual is a student or trainee). **Discounts** are offered for early registration (\$100 if registration is received by January 12, 2008) and for multiple participants from the same organization (contact CIDI-Training@isr.umich.edu for pricing information). Travel and lodging costs are not included.

The training includes home study training materials as well as three days of classroom training. Participants will be expected to complete approximately 30 hours of home study prior to attending training. Upon successful completion of training, participants are certified in the use of the instrument and are given access to the Blaise files for conducting computerized interviews and the data entry program for paper/pencil questionnaires, along with the SAS scoring algorithms for the diagnoses included in the instrument. **A Blaise license is required** for each computer on which the CIDI software is installed.
